Eligibility for Parking Privileges:

- All obligations must be paid
- Must maintain a 2.0 GPA or higher
- Only 11th & 12th grade students who meet the eligibility requirements are eligible for passes

Failure to abide by the following regulations could result in the loss of parking privileges...

1. Parking is a Privilege
 - a. Parking on school grounds is a privilege. Violation of parking rules (outlined below) will result in suspension of driving privileges and/or further disciplinary action.
2. Parking (Where)
 - a. You may not park without a parking pass.
 - b. Parking Pass #'s are associated with an assigned parking spot, therefore you must park in your assigned parking spot.
 - c. Students can not park at the curb, along the grass, behind the building, or in the following lots... Faculty, Athletics, Cafeteria, Bus, Fenced Area behind the School
 - d. Oversized vehicles & dual enrollment students will have pre-identified & assigned parking
3. Displaying Passes
 - a. Parking passes must be in plain sight and hanging from your rearview mirror daily
 - b. Pass holders not displaying the hanging pass will be issued a school warning and/or be asked to move their vehicle off the student parking lot.
 - c. No student to student parking pass transfers and/or trades are allowed
 - d. If a parking pass needs replaced, the cost will be \$5.00. Valid driver's license & vehicle's registration must be resubmitted (along with eligibility requirements being met).
 - e. Students are **not** eligible for a refund if their permit is revoked. The parking space will be issued to the next student on the waiting list.

4. Traffic Norms
 - a. Students are to obey all county and state traffic regulations. **Students are to follow all staff directions, traffic patterns, and One Way directional signs.** School buses have the right-of-way in all parking lots. The speed limit in all parking lots is **15 MPH**.
 - b. Students who drive carelessly on school property will have their parking suspended or revoked

5. Expectations of the Parking Lot
 - a. Students may not sit in their cars while parked on school grounds
 - b. Students are not to leave the building during the school day and lunch periods. First obtain permission from an administrator if you need to get things from your vehicle during the day.
 - c. Passengers are not exempt from expectations. Violations may result in consequences for both driver & passengers.
 - d. Vehicles should remain locked while on school grounds. QACHS is not responsible for lost or stolen property stored in a student's vehicle(s).

6. Automobile Searches
 - a. Automobiles parked on the school premises or in the school parking lot are subject to search when officials have reason to believe that weapons, drugs, or objects prohibited by school policy or state law are contained therein. This includes the use of drug-detecting dogs.

7. Possible Consequences
 - a. Just because you have a parking pass does not mean you cannot be ticketed, issued a school warning/referral, or towed. Some examples that may cause you to be ticketed, warned, or towed include: a) parked in staff area; b) parked in unmarked parking spots; c) parked in handicap of visitor space; d) not having your parking pass properly displayed; e) excessively loud operation of car stereo equipment; f) driving in an unsafe manner.
 - b. Due to infractions of the Parking Regulations or Administrative discretion, a parking permit can be suspended or revoked at any time. Once revoked, there will be no refund.
 - c. If you have any questions at any time concerning the parking policies or parking tickets you have received, please see an administrator by 3 PM on the same day the warning is received.

Violations of the above guidelines may result in suspension of driving privileges and/or towing. Students will be responsible for towing fees. There will be no refunds for revoked parking privileges. The parking space will go to the next student on the waiting list.

Other Violations that may result in loss of privileges...

1. Excessive tardiness or unexcused absenteeism (less than 8)
2. Students not maintaining a 2.0 GPA
3. Other violations determined by the Principals or Assistant Principals
