1. Executive Committee Reports:

b. Concert & Symphonic Bands are working hard at rehearsals in preparation for the Pops Concert on October 25th. Monday 2 weeks from now will be the dress rehearsal 10/24. Tuesday will be the performance at 7pm

c. Friday Night 10/7 at the Football Game against Easton is our Senior Night for the Band. The Game is at 6pm so the band will make their way to the field at 5:30 and set up for the National Anthem. The Seniors will be announced and then proceed immediately to the field for the National Anthem

- d. **ACC's- 11/6 – 11/7** paperwork has been handed out and **MUST** be returned by October 15th. **5 Chaperones will be needed.** This is a Tier 2 chaperoned event so; you must fill out the appropriate paperwork and be fingerprinted with the QAC Board of Ed. The paperwork is available on the QACHS website under AMY TAYLOR'S teacher page. The BOE will contact you for an appointment for fingerprinting after the paperwork is processed. Pre-Sale of tickets to the Competition @ Hershey Stadium are **HIGHLY** recommended. Cost is \$22 with a savings of \$5 (\$27@the gate) Reservations at the Hotel with the Band are also available at the group's rate of \$95 per room.
- e. **SPRING TRIP-** Its official!! There will be a letter coming out about the Spring Trip to Virginia. April 27th, 28th, 29th & 30th
Cost of the trip per Student will be \$380. The Deposit of \$75 will be due October 21st After the Deposit is paid, you can elect to pay \$75 monthly or the balance all at once. If your student has money in their Band account, on the payment slip, please notify the Treasurer in writing that you would like to use those funds towards the spring trip. The cost of the trip includes: Transportation, Hotel, Breakfast every morning, Tickets to Bush Gardens for Saturday (including the Bush Gardens Meal plan), Admission into Nauticus/Battleship Wisconsin.

4. New Business: All Shore 2023 was to be held April 14th and 15th at Easton High School. They are now unable to host. It was proposed to the Band Boosters to hold it at Queen Anne's. Necessities: Truck to pull the trailer on Thursday night and Saturday night to pick up and deliver KHS instruments in order to have enough instruments for the event. 2 Volunteers all Day Friday (or 4 people in 2 different shifts) 4 Volunteers all day Saturday (or 8 people 2 shifts). Someone to handle a snack table/ concession table in the lobby, Someone to schedule the caterer, Someone to handle the T-shirt orders and sales of fundraiser items. Bob made a Motion to Approve that QA host this event. Brian McMullen 2nd.
